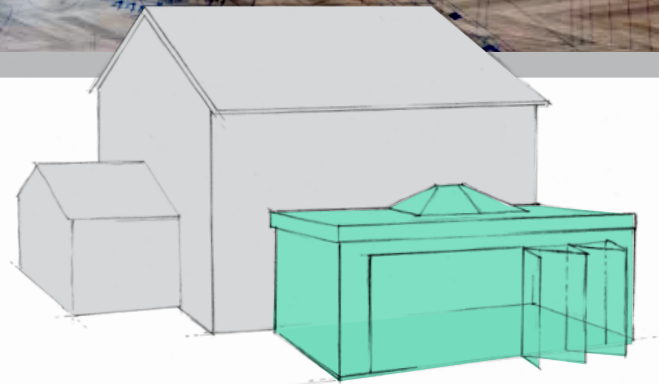

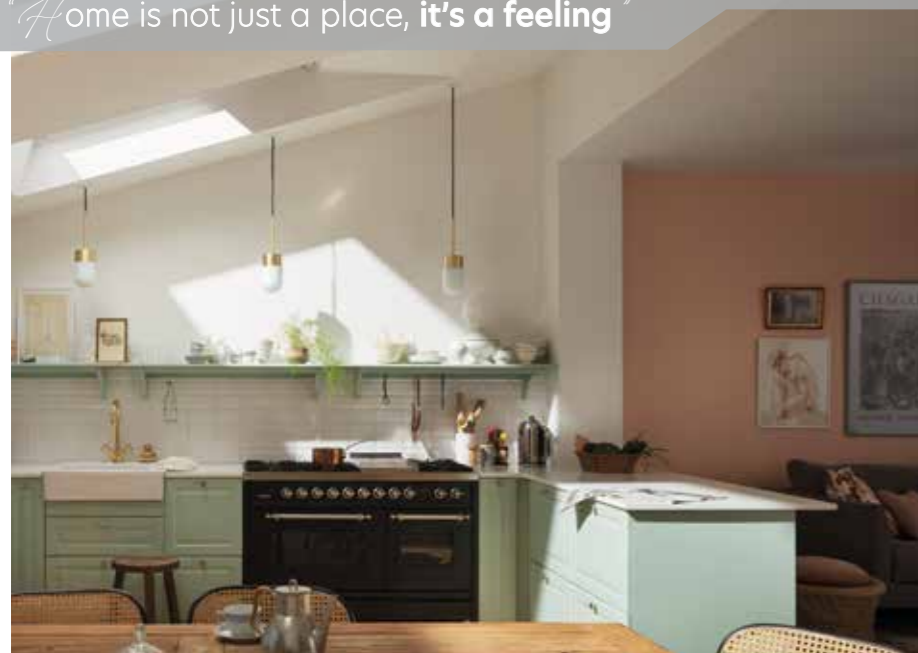

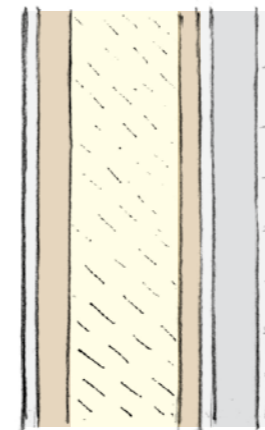
Advanced & sustainable technology for superior thermal performance

Ensuring your new extension is well insulated and uses energy efficiently is a key priority. That's why the Guardian Home Extension is constructed using the highly insulated and innovative Kingspan TEK® Building System, coupled with the market leading Guardian Warm Roof system. Both systems have been rigorously tested to ensure they exceed the required thermal performance set by building regulations.

The Guardian Warm Wall will comfortably achieve a thermal performance U-value of 0.18 W/m²k once fully constructed with interior and exterior finishes. To achieve the same thermal performance from a traditional brick build construction would require a wall thickness almost double that of the Guardian Warm Wall.

CROSS SECTION

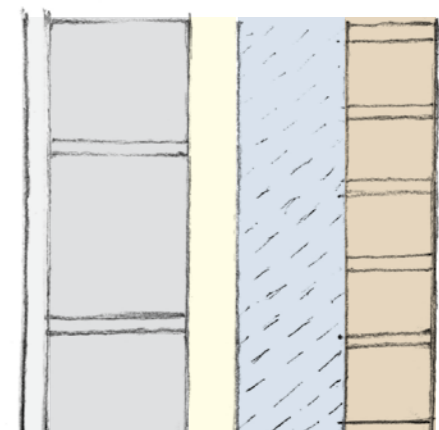

With working from home now commonplace for many office-based employees, whether your work is fully remote or hybrid, a dedicated home office space has quickly moved from the realms of nice-to-have-luxury, to an essential requirement in today's home. Creating an extension that accommodates this need can be transformative, even with a relatively modest add-on, as well as providing space for crafts, hobbies and side hustles, too.

Greens and blues are well known to help create a sense of calm, though in a working space it's also important to feel inspired: going bold and creating an immersive feel with wraparound teal walls, and a jolt of contrasting raspberry trim on woodwork, will help keep motivation levels up, while opting for a mint green finish across door and window frames nods to the outside space leading directly off this room.

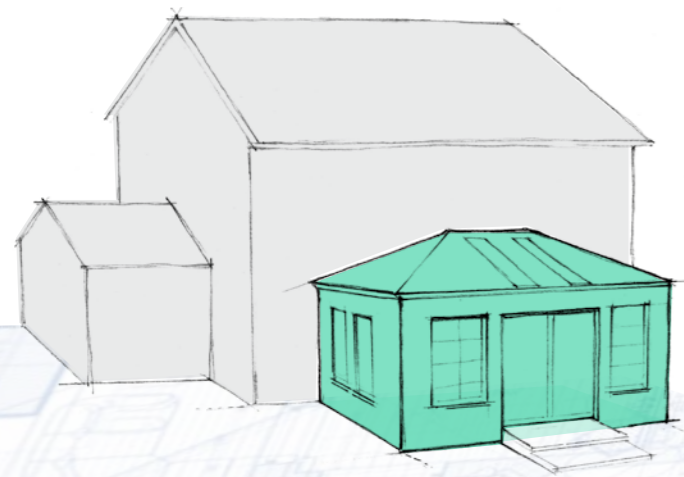

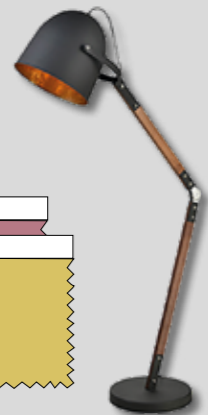
Make the most of an add-on extension by ensuring it works in a multitude of ways, for all members of the family. By utilising existing double doors as access into the new space (where they had previously led directly into the garden), you can avoid the complications of knocking down internal walls, creating a room which feels connected to the rest of the house that's also private (perfect for noisy child's play or teenage get-togethers!)

Decorating a family-friendly room needn't mean a compromise on adult aesthetics - instead, lean into bright colours and graphic shapes for a dopamine-filled look that feels fun and energetic. Stripes can be a great way to add interest without visual overwhelm, so use them creatively, such as laying striped flooring diagonally across the space, or adding contrasting bands of colour to the tops of your walls. Opting for Crittal-style glazing also picks up on this motif: anthracite is a smart (and highly popular) colour choice, but you could also go bold and spec a bright tone here, too.

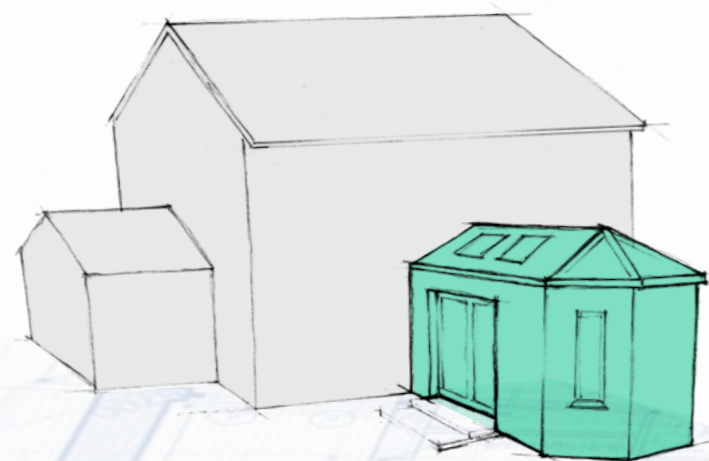

Rising housing and care home costs are leading more families to live together across the generations, for both practical and financial purposes. Adding a self-contained bedroom space downstairs can be invaluable for supporting fluctuating needs, from offering an adult child more privacy and freedom, serving as an assisted living suite for an elderly family member, or simply acting as dedicated space for overnight guests. Double doors leading into the garden means the room can be independently accessed, while family members remain close by if needed.

To ensure this space has a tranquil feel, and to enhance a feeling of connection to the garden, choose comforting sage greens and muted blues to aid relaxation while leaving wooden window and door trims in their natural finish. These natural materials can also be picked up elsewhere in the space, from cosy cork flooring topped with a jute rug, to earthy tones and organic shapes selected for cushions and accessories. Opting for a sofa bed or a double daybed means the space can function as a second living room when not required as a permanent sleeping space. And while fully insulated, the addition of a wood-burning stove at the far end creates a characterful focal point and additional feeling of retreat during colder months.

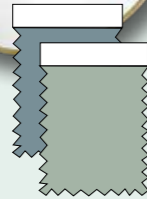

"If your space has a lovely view to the outside, bring that in by adding a cluster of mirrors to the wall opposite, in place of artwork, for a subtle effect."

"Privacy and light reduction are imperative in sleeping spaces: ensure windows and roof lights are equipped with blackout blinds. Thick, full-length curtains across double doors will also aid privacy and provide a soft, cocooning feel!"

"Look for furniture which doesn't obviously scream 'bedroom', to aid the versatility of the space... 'low cabinet wardrobes', which incorporate a single hanging rail for tops and folded-over bottoms and dresses, look like everyday living room storage but function just as well as a standard wardrobe."

"Lighting is a key ingredient when it comes to creating calm: incorporate lighting from several sources where possible, including bedside and floor lamps, and install overhead lights on dimmer switches, to aid a pre-sleep evening wind-down."

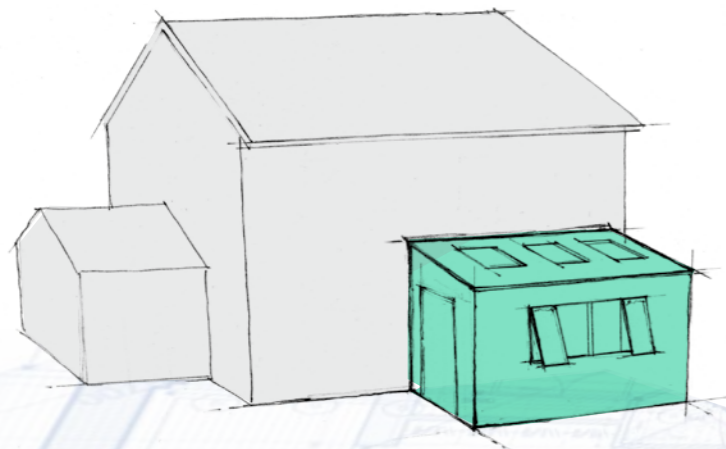

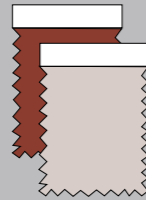

Extensions don't necessarily need to be physically large to make a big impact: sometimes, simply having a little more space to spread out for daily housekeeping jobs or maintenance tasks can help your whole home run a lot more smoothly, without eating up too much exterior square footage.

When it comes to creating a utility room, don't overlook the aesthetics: yes, this is a functional 'working' space but it will make chores feel easier if the environment is a pleasant one to be in (and if space permits, you could even sneak in an armchair to act as a corner of respite). Practicality is key, so bring in hard-working surfaces like wood and metal, opt for easy-clean flooring such as tiles or vinyl, and include lashings of storage and shelving alongside a few aesthetic pieces such as plants and pretty storage baskets.

Industrial accents make sense here, but equally bringing in some country-style elements can help create a look that feels smart-rustic rather than austere. Utilising simple block designs, such as chequerboard flooring and a graphic patterned floor runner, will add interest and personality, and can provide you with a colour palette to pick up on across walls and skirting boards, to tie the space together.
